Tibet Pioneers

The sisters rested overnight in Beijing, China before going on to the "Top of the World" Tibet, with its 12,000-foot mountains, the prize for many mountain climbers. Climbers from around the world flock to these mountains. Other visitors come to view the Buddhist temples and monasteries. These sisters did not come to climb nor were they interested in earthly temples. Their goal was to reach the hearts of Tibetans with the Spirit of the Living God.

During the next morning, they flew to the capital city, Laska. They prayer walked around the exterior of numerous Buddhist temples and monasteries unwinding what had been bound up, as they walked counter clockwise. Tibetans, spinning their prayer wheels walk around the Dalai Lama's palace in a clockwise direction.

God had called the sisters to sound the Trumpet Call to the four winds from the top of the mountains, and like the Prophet Ezekiel to speak to the dry bones of the Tibetan people, redeem the land of Tibet and dedicate it to the Lord. They witnessed desperate and impoverished people hungry for God, and looking for answers. Yet, they were completely ignorant of the Risen Savior. The sisters' tour guide spent 9 years in a monastery studying Buddhism, human philosophy, and astrology, and had never heard the name of Jesus Christ. These ladies had the joy of giving him a gospel tract that he was able to read in his Tibetan language.

Another part of their Tibet assignment was to deliver the "Living

Bread". In Tibet there is a great need for the Word of God in the language of the people. The team was unable to find Bibles printed in the Tibetan language, so Bibles in Mandarin Chinese were given as gifts to the Tibetan people. Please pray for this need that the Word of God can be printed in the language of the Tibetan people. Another ministry with great possibilities is to reach the youth of Tibet with the gospel. If this new generation can be won to the Savior, all of Tibet could be reached in their lifetime.

The sisters' return trip from Laska, Tibet to Beijing, China was a 25-hour train encounter with a cross section of Tibetan society. After a session of prayer and worship, the Holy Spirit directed Tibetan university students, peasants and other members of Tibetan society to the sisters' berth. The gospel and the ministry of the Holy Spirit overwhelmed the Tibetans. They entered the sisters' berth, overcome by their need to receive Jesus as their Savior. After their salvation experience they encountered genuine joy and peace. Tears of joy streamed down some of their faces as the Love of Christ flooded their souls. When they were given a Bible in Mandarin Chinese they kissed the cover because they were grateful for this wonderful gift. Other Tibetans waited in the small hallway outside the sisters' berth, patiently standing and soaking in this atmosphere of the ministry and anointing of the Holy Spirit. One Tibetan lady who had received Christ as Savior asked the sisters to pray for her husband. He had an excruciating toothache and was lying in his berth in a different section of the train. The sisters prayed for her husband and a short time later she returned with a thankful heart and the joyful news that the toothache was gone. Glory to God!

Back in Beijing God directed the sisters to visit the "Temple of Heaven." As they stood in front of the main gate a large crowd of Chinese surrounded them. Those in front took photographs of the sisters; others asked to be photographed with the sisters. The sisters were "Celebrities for Christ" at the "Temple of Heaven" and the bearers of His Glory to these hungry, thirsting souls. When the crowd dispersed, the sisters prayer walked the temple courtyard and placed Chinese gospel tracts in the planter boxes. Only God knows which hungry hearts will find the tracts and accept Jesus as Savior and Lord!
